12 Things to Know About DNA Testing

1. Test with one of the “Big Three DNA Testing Companies”: Ancestry, FamilyTreeDNA, and/or 23andMe.
2. Autosomal DNA (atDNA) will answer almost all questions.
3. Start your atDNA testing at Ancestry, then transfer your results to FamilyTreeDNA.
4. Mitochondrial DNA and Y-DNA answers specific questions and provide deep ethnicity estimates.
5. FamilyTreeDNA is the only company to fully test mitochondrial DNA and Y-DNA.
6. Test your oldest people first.
7. FamilyTreeDNA is a good place to test older people because they use a swab test.
8. Test parents, cousins, aunts and uncles to sort your DNA matches.
9. Siblings will match different distant cousins.
10. DNA matches can help you, so help them.
11. Ethnicity estimates are estimates, but can help sort matches.
12. Third party tools can help you. These include GEDMatch.com & DNAGedcom.com
