- Four levels of subscriptions (Premium, Pro, Plus, Starter) on monthly or yearly basis, plus micro-payments options to view individual transcripts and records. Searching site is always free and thumbnail views are often quite useful. Loyalty of 15% offered for discounts on renewals.
 - Register for a free account to do searches and view free records. Check site every Friday for new records added. FMP is often available at Family Search Centers and public libraries.
 - Strength is British Empire including: England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland, Ireland, Channel Islands, Isle of Man, Jersey, Gibraltar, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, India. US records collections are growing, especially Catholic records.
 - 50 million Parish records – Births / Baptisms/ Banns / Marriages / Deaths / Burials / Probates. This is based on Civil Registration districts made up of multiple parishes merged together. Registration was not strictly enforced until 1875.
 - Order post-1837 Birth / Marriage / Death certificates from website www.GRO.gov.UK for £ 11.00 and receive in about 1 week by PDF download for another £ 7.00. Keep in mind these events are entered when they were registered, not when event occurred. So, check the next quarter period. In 2016, the site added Mother's Maiden Name, as a filter.

- Records cover broad areas: Church / Religion / Education / Work / Travel / Migration / Military, Armed forces and World Conflicts / Census, land, and surveys/ Directories / Social History / Institutions/ Newspapers / Periodicals/ 1939 Register
- England and Wales Census with images 1841 – 1921
 ** (OTP = of this Parish / Sojourner = not permanent of this Parish)
 1921 – View all with a Premium subscription
 1931 - Destroyed due to WWII
 1941 - Not taken due to WWII

The 1939 Register of 40 million people in England & Wales, can act as a Census substitute.

- Scotland Census 1841- 1901 transcriptions only. Must pay to view originals at <https://www.scotlandspeople.gov.uk/>
- Ireland Census 1821-1851 images (very incomplete)
 1901-1911 transcriptions only, view images at <http://www.nationalarchives.ie/> for free
 1926 will be released in January 2027
- Irish Catholic Parish Registers - 10 million indexed records 1589 to 1916 in English and Latin (will always be free to view)
- Irish Directories, Canada Militia 1919, New Zealand Nominal Rolls 1871, School Registers, Quaker Church Registers, Royal Servants, Australian Convicts, Irish Petty Sessions, Unique Irish Land & Estate records, & Dog Licenses, British & Irish Roots.

- Immigration and Travel Records from UK to US 1890-1960. Many immigrants from Europe went thru British ports to get to the United States. Did you ancestors migrate to Australia?
- 12.5 million Military Records from around the world including the American War for Independence, Waterloo, Boer Wars, WWI, WWII, Medal Rolls and Honors, & Regimental Records.
- British & Irish Newspapers covering 1700 to 2022 - Almost 20 million articles free to view and 696 million with subscription.
- Upload a GEDCOM file or create your own family tree. Then, attach records, get hints, and connect with relatives.
- Library Edition does not allow viewing of UK, US, Irish Newspapers, creation of online trees, DNA test results from <https://livingdna.com/> nor UK Electoral Registers.
